Member Bursary Policy

10.8.1 Member Bursaries – Full-Time and Part-Time Studies

- (1) Ten full-time and ten part-time bursaries are available annually to CUPE Local 15 members.
 - a) Full-time bursaries are to a maximum of \$1,200 of tuition only.
 - b) Part-time bursaries are to a maximum of \$600 of tuition only.
 - c) Bursaries are paid directly to the institution upon receipt of invoices and proof of registration.
 - d) Bursaries will be paid in two equal amounts; ½ applied to the first semester attended during the academic year, and ½ applied to second semester attended.
 - e) The academic year is defined as September to the following August.

(2) Eligibility

To be eligible for a full-time or part-time bursary, the member must satisfy the following criteria:

- a) Must be a current member of the union in good standing at the time of application.
- b) Must demonstrate a primary attachment to CUPE Local 15 by holding union membership through a minimum of six months employment for each of the two years prior to the date of enrolment.
- c) Must be pursuing a field of study not in contradiction to the aims of the labour movement.
- d) Must be attending a Canadian public post-secondary institution, and beginning or continuing full-time or part-time studies as defined by the Canada Student Financial Assistance Act.
- e) Students receiving scholarship funding equal to or in excess of full tuition are not eligible.
- f) Students receiving partial funding from other sources will be eligible for the amount of remaining unpaid tuition, up to the bursary maximum.

(3) Selection

- a) The award selection will be approved by the Society Board.
- b) Awards will be based upon the highest level of aggregate service, measured from the start date.
- c) A member may only be awarded a bursary once every four years.

(4) Application

The application period is June of each year. Applications must be received at the union office by June 30th.
